Apilac 5 mg

Pharmaceutical form: rectal suppositories.

Composition: 1 suppository contains 5 mg lyophilized Royal Jelly.

Pharmacological group: biostimulant of natural origin. General tonics and adaptogens.

Indications:

Apilac biosuppositories as a prophylactic agent can be used in newborns and infants with

malnutrition (hypotrophy) and lack of appetite (anorexia).

Contraindications: The use of Biosuppositories with royal jelly is contraindicated in cases

of allergic reactions to bee products, Addison's disease.

Side effects: Highly sensitive people may occur sleep disturbances, which requires a dose

reduction or discontinuation of the product.

Posology and method of administration: Premature and newborn babies prescribe 2.5 mg,

and infants older than 1 month - 5 mg in the form of suppositories 3 times a day.

Suppositories can be used for 7-15 days.

Storage conditions:

Store below 20°C. Keep out of reach of children.

Shelf life:

2 years.
