

## **Apilac 5 mg**

**Pharmaceutical form:** rectal suppositories.

**Composition:** 1 suppository contains 5 mg lyophilized Royal Jelly.

**Pharmacological group:** biostimulant of natural origin. General tonics and adaptogens.

### **Indications:**

Apilac biosuppositories as a prophylactic agent can be used in newborns and infants with malnutrition (hypotrophy) and lack of appetite (anorexia).

**Contraindications:** The use of Biosuppositories with royal jelly is contraindicated in cases of allergic reactions to bee products, Addison's disease.

**Side effects:** Highly sensitive people may occur sleep disturbances, which requires a dose reduction or discontinuation of the product.

**Posology and method of administration:** Premature and newborn babies prescribe 2.5 mg, and infants older than 1 month - 5 mg in the form of suppositories 3 times a day. Suppositories can be used for 7-15 days.

### **Storage conditions:**

Store below 20°C. Keep out of reach of children.

### **Shelf life:**

2 years.
