

CASTOR OIL 60 ml

Pharmaceutical form: oil for external and oral use, with banana, mint and cherry flavor.

Pharmacological group: laxative.

Indications:

Acute and chronic constipation (including before and after surgery) and to facilitate bowel movements with hemorrhoids and anal fissures, in preparation for a diagnostic study.

Indications in medicine

Due to the absence of irritating properties, castor oil is recommended for use in inflammatory of the gastrointestinal tract, ulcerative colitis and fever, constipation, blockage, and gastrointestinal toxicity. It is also used to treatment of ulcers, burns, soften the skin, and also as a remedy that improves hair growth.

Contraindications:

Intestinal obstruction, abdominal pain of unknown etiology, poisoning with fat-soluble substances (phosphorus, benzene, etc.), pregnancy, children up to one-year-old.

Dosage and method of administration:

Castor oil is a mild laxative. It is used in a dosage 15-30 ml, for children 5-15 ml (for adults - a tablespoon, for children - a tea or dessert spoon). After taking castor oil, a laxative effect occurs after 4-5 hours or earlier. (1 teaspoon = 5ml).

Warnings and Precautions:

Do not use as a laxative for more than 3 days.

Side effects:

With long-term use at a therapeutic dose, may develops intestinal atony.

Indications in cosmetology

Haircare (Strengthening):

With abundant hair loss: mix castor oil equally quantity of medical alcohol. Apply to hair roots. Wash your hair after 1-2 hours. Rinse with acidified water: juice of 1/2 lemon is squeezed into the rinse water or 1-2 tablespoons of vinegar are added.

Note: it is quite difficult to wash the oil from the hair, but it is possible with using shampoo. Rinse your head after the procedure especially carefully.

Eyelashes:

daily brushing with castor oil (use a well rinsed mascara brush) will help make your lashes long, thick and fluffy.

It is possible to apply castor oil 2-3 times weekly carefully to rub the upper and lower lashes.

Wart removal treatment:

Rub in the morning and evening on the wart for at least five minutes. Use until the wart disappears.

Packaging:

60 ml bottle with dosage cup.

Shelf life:

3 years.

Storage conditions:

Store in a cool, dark place in a tightly closed dark containers.

After opening refrigerate.

Regulatory status:

Over the counter (OTC).
